Twenty-five years ago, I was sitting in my office at Berkshire Community College when I received a call from Hank Payne, the President of Williams College. He told me to expect a request for an appointment from Tom and Judy Easton, a couple interested in starting an adult learning program. Since Hank's mother was an avid participant in Elderhostel (now Road Scholars), he asked that I take the appointment and consider their request.

Tom and Judy were impressive. I was happy to support an idea that fit perfectly with the community college mission of serving individuals from pre-school through older adult. Thanks to Alexandra Warshaw, then BCC's Dean of Continuing Education, her staff, and a dedicated group of volunteers, the Berkshire Institute for Lifelong Learning, BILL, became a reality. Through the unique partnership between a public community college and an elite liberal arts college we were able to provide funding, administrative support, and faculty. Then as now, the participants themselves controlled the curriculum.

I was privileged to have many opportunities to interact with Tom, Judy and the others who formed BILL's core leadership team. Each was an opportunity to be in awe of their intellectual strengths and curiosity. At one Sunday evening dinner they were dissecting the Sunday New York Times, which they had read in its entirety, comparing one of the Magazine's articles with the author's prior work. I had barely finished the news section. Jealous of their time and talent, I promised myself that someday I would be part of a lifelong program as challenging and rewarding as the one they had created.

And here I am, a member of BILL's second iteration, OLLI at BCC, taking courses, attending special events, mentoring a BCC student and making friends. I don't know where the 25 years went, but I am grateful to be here celebrating with all of you.

We look forward to the continued growth, creativity and vitality of OLLI for the next 25 years and beyond. Together we'll ensure that lifelong learning is available to everyone.



The Breca Rosé is considered "a very elegant rosé presenting a pale pink hue in the glass. On the nose, it presents beautiful floral aromas, as well as red fruit, including strawberry."


What fun you'll have pairing this lovely rosé with a cheese course, a favorite entrée, or dessert!

Thank you to Domaney's Liquors and Fine Wines in Great Barrington for donating this case of wonderful wines consisting of six bottles of Vino Winery's 2015 Pinot Grigio and six bottles of Rosemont Estate's Diamond Label 2017 Shiraz.

Vino is a Washington state winery, and its 2015 Pinot Grigio has received a 90 point "best buy" rating from Wine Enthusiast. This lovely pinot has been described as "spot on for the variety, with notes of whole Granny Smith apple and green melon. The palate redolent with sleek fresh apple and pear flavors that power through the finish."

Rosemont Estate is a South Australia winery, and its Diamond Label 2017 Shiraz is considered "a rich and generous wine, with dark plum, black cherry and blackberry notes." This shiraz "pairs beautifully with hearty, richly seasoned dishes, red meats or the sharp bite of a strong cheddar." The perfect wine for a winter evening meal by the fire!
